Note: For each item, the “College Mean” represents the average score among the 620 sections that participated in the survey. The standard deviation (Std Dev) represents the variability in the means. In addition, the table provides percentile rank information for each item. You can determine the percentile rank of your class average for any item by matching it to the scores within the table. For example, if your class average for the first item “The instructor is prepared for each class meeting.” is 4.77, then you would be in the 50th percentile among your SCCC peers for item one. Each item has slightly different norms.
